You want us to go to the Earlton P.O. that's 3 miles the other way on state Rt. 81 in the middle of no were. No food, no gas no banking Earlton has a firehouse and a vet's office and the P.O.. With today's gas prices people want to make one trip and try to get everything done and save gas. You have a petition with over 300 people signed that agree they want the climax P.O. open.

They had one meeting on closing of climax P.O. held at Earlton P.O. Not Climax, we only had a 2 week notice about the meeting it was at 5PM on a week day. People were still at work or running there business and couldn't come and other people wouldn't drive to Earlton for the meeting. Why wasn't it held at the post office that was up for closing? It was in the newspaper after our meeting saying who ever had the most people at the meeting wasn't gong to be closed. That is some way to run a business. 300 people walked in the climax P.O. and signed the petition to keep the climax post office open.
