We were told that this closure would not affect the town much. We would just have to go to Brownville Ne 68321 which is 7 miles away. Or go to Sikeston Ne 68431 8 miles away. Now both of those towns are up for disclosure also. We would have to drive clear to Auburn Ne 68303 which is 15 miles away.

Nemaha has quite a elderly population and this is going to have a big effect on the town & business.

The town has taken a pretty bad hit with the flood of the Missouri River. It backed up in the Nemaha and they both flooded quite a bit of farm ground.

We lost a lot of farm ground both in Nebraska & Oklahoma.

Quite a few farmers has suffered thousand of dollars of loss.

A lot of people could not get to work because of bridges out.

We've had Cooper Nuclear Plant given to Brownville Mo. when it should have been put in this town since its closer.

We've had our rural carrier taken out of this office & based out of Brownville.

When the postmaster retired they did not fill the position.

They brought in a rural
Carrier to OIC for 2 years
a month for \$57⁰⁰ an hour
which could not be offset
by sales. But the Post Office
did that to us. Now we have
another OIC for 2 years
making \$11⁰⁰ an hour. The sales
have been up (til the flood)
but not enough since they
took half our business
away.

When Cooper Nuclear shuts
down they bring in approximately
1500 people. We have 2 RV parks
that fill up & every other available
spot fills up.
