By means of Order No. 992 (November 22, 2011), the Postal Regulatory Commission docketed correspondence from customers of the Deering, Missouri Post Office, assigning PRC Docket No. A2012-58 as an appeal pursuant to 39 U.S.C. § 404(d). That Order, at page 3, set November 22, 2011 as the date by which “[t]he Postal Service shall file the applicable administrative record regarding this appeal” or “any responsive pleading.” On November 22, 2011, the Postal Service filed an incomplete version of the administrative record.¹ Today the Postal Service files the complete administrative record concerning the Final Determination to Close the Deering, MO Post Office and Establish Service by Rural Route Service.
