

Dear Ms Goldway:

This letter serves as an appeal of the USPS final determination to close the post office in Jonesville, Texas 75659. Keeping our Jonesville Post Office matters a great deal to the Jonesville Community as well as to the owners of T. C. Lindsey & Co. As a business owner, I fully understand the need to curtail costs so that money is not lost. Our whole nation has become more conscious of financial problems in recent times.

I would like for the decision about closing the Jonesville Post Office 75659 to be appealed based on the following reasons:

- The risk of delivery of our business's mail to an unattended roadside mailbox is not an option for our business due to the monetary transactions that we currently have and plan to have in the future.
- After writing letters to the U.S. postal service, I only received a standardized response. My questions involving safety and cost of relocating T. C. Lindsey & Co. to another post office were not answered. The evidence of the Jonesville Post Office losing money was never explained, and on the contrary, the post office records in Jonesville say that we actually increased our revenue over the last two years.

- Having our postal service relocated to another area will hurt our business. The delivery of our correspondence and packages to the present post office has been very close to our business. If we have to send an employee to get our mail in a nearby town, it will seriously affect our mail deliveries and the hours our business can stay in operation. It will not just be inconvenient, but it will be a cost factor, as well.
- Closing the post office in Jonesville will have a negative effect on our community and will not save the postal service money. Thorough research of our community and our needs were not taken prior to putting the Jonesville Post Office on the closure list. Accurate portrayals of our Jonesville post office finances and community needs were not given to those who needed to make this important decision.
- Even though we are a rural community, we want to have services available to us that urban areas have, too.

Thank you for your consideration of this matter.
