MEMO TO RECORD

SUBJECT: Mountain City Post Office Administrative Record

After review of the Administrative Record for the discontinuance of the Mountain City Post Office, the following information is added to clarify certain statements. The information below is organized by the Item number corresponding to the Administrative Record.

Item No. 17

Item 17 indicates that there would be an additional cost to discontinuing the Mountain City Post Office if customers choose to utilize street delivery.

Item No. 33 & Final Determination

Item No. 33 and the Final Determination indicated there will not be an additional cost if the Mountain City Post Office closes. The documents should indicate that the Mountain City Post Office will incur an estimated cost of \$4,028.17 if the customers of Mountain City opt for street delivery. The breakdown is below:

With 72 boxes added to the route, multiplied by 3.64 hours per year, would result in an additional 262.08 hours added to the route, multiply that by \$15.37 per hour rate will equal to \$4,028.17 annual cost.
