I am writing you to file my complaint about closing the Bovill, Idaho Post Office. You don't even have the right information about our town. You have down that "Bovill is an unincorporated community". We are an incorporated town, we have a mayor and a city council. We receive tax money. We also have a Bovill Fire District that is supported by tax dollars. We are not a farming community, we are a logging community. There are a number of people living in town that are in the logging industry. We do not have a Lutheran Church in Bovill, it is a Presbyterian Church. I don't know who gave you the information about the town, but they sure didn't know much about it. If you got your information from Tammy Hoisington, the former Postmaster, she hated the town and was out to do whatever she could to hurt it as much as she could.
