**MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of the filing of the responses to the questions 1, 2(a) and 16 of Presiding Officer's Information Request No. 1. Identification of responsive information and development of thorough answers to all of the questions have been diligently pursued from the time the POIR was first filed. The time taken to file the responses is a result of the complexity of certain questions and to the need for (sometimes extensive) cross-functional coordination and review, the press of Docket No. N2012-1 and other equally important postal business. Today's responses are being filed seven calendar days late. The Postal Service regrets the delay, but believes that any prejudice is minimal.
