**DBP/USPS-30** In the past year or two the Postal Service has reduced the accessibility of access to the entry of various categories of mail at the Bulk Mail Entry Units [BMEU] throughout the country.

- [a] Please advise the facilities in New Jersey that now permit the entry of Bulk Mail at their facility.
- [b] Please confirm or explain that all other New Jersey facilities no longer permit the entry of Bulk Mail at their facility.
- [c] Please discuss the reduction of BMEUs that have occurred in the other 49 states.
- [d] Should the Northern New Jersey Metro P&DC consolidate its operation to the DVD P&DC as proposed, will a BMEU be maintained at the NNJ Metro BMEU?

- (b) The BMEUs identified in response to subpart (a) are the only BMEUs that accept commercial mail in the State of New Jersey.
- (c) The USPS has consolidated approximately 1,000 BMEUs nationwide since January 1, 2011, including approximately 40 in New Jersey.
- (d) There is currently no BMEU at the NNJ Metro facility.
