Making the Daisy post office is losing money, but it has operated without a post master the past 2 1/2 years, and if you asked any one in Daisy the service is outstanding. Of course the postal service has cost the Daisy post office business since the notice was announced for considering ~~the~~ closing of the Daisy post office.
