The United States Postal Service hereby provides a revised version of the January 14, 1999, update of witness Seckar's response to the question posed by the Presiding Officer at the hearing on November 20, 1998. This revision reflects the addition of \$48,305 in telecommunications cost by witness Lim in response to interrogatory OCA/USPS-ST9-12(b), filed February 2, 1999. The impact is minor. The only change in the actual response is the resulting increase in the incremental cost figures. The changed numbers in the attached worksheets are highlighted.


The question is paraphrased and is followed by the response.

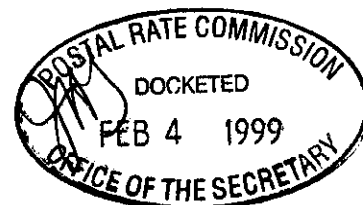


