QUERIES

1. count of finance numbers—Identified Finance Numbers used for more than one plant
2. Daily Rent costs each Finance – Calculates daily Rent by dividing Line Number 41 by 365 days per year.
3. Daily Utility costs each Finance - Calculates daily utility by dividing Line Number 42 by 365 days per year.
4. FDB Facilities filtered for Operations - Subset Facility (from FDB) Table to where Facility Type not equal “ADMIN” and Facility Category not equal “DELV\_RETAIL” And Facility Category not equal to "CUST\_SERV"
5. Output to LoginNet with RealCosts (no deprec)- Generates Fixed Opening Cost, Fixed Operating Cost, and Fixed Closing cost for input to LogicNet model.

6. Overhead Costs for model - creates table that has both daily rent and daily utility cost.
