**MOTION OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE  
OF WITNESS ELMORE-YALCH'S RESPONSE TO PRESIDING OFFICER'S  
INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 2**

(January 27, 2012)

The United States Postal Service moves for late acceptance of the filing of witness Elmore-Yalch's response to question 10 of Presiding Officer's Information Request No. 2. In this instance, early recognition of the relatively simple response led to its having been set aside in favor of more complex and lengthy analyses responding to other discovery; as such, the delay is one of inadvertence. Given that the response indicates no changes to analysis previously supplied materials are necessary or appropriate, it does not seem possible that prejudice can arise; in any circumstance, it cannot be more than minimal.
