**UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE MOTION FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF

The United States Postal Service moves for late acceptance of the filing of the response to question 28(a)-(d) and (f) of the Chairman's Information Request No. 1. The time taken to file the response is a result of the need for (sometimes extensive) cross-functional coordination and review, and the press of Docket No. N2012-1 and other equally important postal business. Today's response is filed five business days late. The Postal Service regrets the delay, but believes that any prejudice is minimal.
