UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE MOTION FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF
RESPONSES TO CHAIRMAN'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 1
AND CHAIRMAN'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 2
(February 8, 2012)

The United States Postal Service moves for late acceptance of the filing today of its responses to Questions 7, 28(e), 28(g), and 38 of Chairman's Information Request No. 1, and to Questions 19-22 of Chairman's Information Request No. 2. The former responses are eight business days light, and the latter responses are one business day late. The delay resulted from the need for (sometimes extensive) cross-functional coordination and review, and the press of Docket No. N2012-1 and other equally important postal business. The Postal Service regrets the delay, but believes that any prejudice is minimal.
