PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING
GRANTING AMERICAN POSTAL WORKERS UNION, AFL-CIO
MOTION FOR ACCESS TO NON-PUBLIC INFORMATION

(Issued February 10, 2012)

On February 9, 2012, the American Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO (APWU) filed a motion pursuant to 39 CFR 3001.21 and 39 CFR 3007.40 to allow certain of its representatives, consultants, and attorneys access to the materials filed in the non-public annex of this docket as library reference USPS-LR-N2012-1/NP12.¹ Statement of Compliance with Protective Conditions certifications are included with the Motion. APWU asserts that it has conferred with Postal Service counsel and that the Postal Service has no objection to granting access to the material. Thus, APWU requests that the Commission waive the 3-day waiting period provided for potential Postal Service objection, and grant immediate access to the material.
