**NOTICE OF INTENT OF INTERVENOR NATIONAL ASSOCIATION
OF LETTER CARRIERS, AFL-CIO TO CONDUCT ORAL CROSS-
EXAMINATION OF USPS WITNESSES
(Feb. 24, 2012)**

Pursuant to Rule 30(e)(3) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and the Commission's January 12, 2012 Procedural Schedule in this case, Intervenor National Association of Letter Carriers, AFL-CIO ("NALC") hereby provides notice of its intent to conduct oral cross-examination of the following USPS witnesses:

1. Rebecca Elmore-Yalch (USPS-T-11) – The topics to be covered include USPS's quantitative and qualitative market research and its projections of loss of mail volume. Cross-examination will include reference to pages 7-12, 44-52, 82-83 and 139-151 of Ms. Elmore-Yalch's testimony as well as her responses to NALC's interrogatories.
2. Greg Whiteman (USPS-T-12) – The topics to be covered include USPS's quantitative and qualitative market research and its projections of loss of mail volume. Cross-examination will include reference to pages 3-22 of his testimony as well as his responses to NALC's interrogatories.
