**NOTICE OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE REGARDING FILING OF
REVISED PUBLIC LIBRARY REFERENCE USPS-LR-N2012-1/11 [ERRATA]**
(March 19, 2012)

The United States Postal Service hereby provides notice today that it is filing a revised version of public library reference USPS-LR-N2012-1/11. The library reference is witness foundational material (Category 2). The version of USPS-LR-N2012-1/11 filed today reflects the following revisions to the “Plant-to-Plant Transportation Summary” table under the “Plant to Plant Summary” tab in the Excel workbook “Transportation Spreadsheets LR” filed previously under USPS-LR-N2012-1/11:

- The total number of routes for the “Cap Metro” Area is changed from “48” to “49”.
- The total number of routes for all areas is changed from “322” to “323”.
- The number of potential trips eliminated from the Eastern Area is changed from “156” to “143”.
- The number of potential trips eliminated from the Great Lakes Area is changed from “67” to “69”.
- The total number of potential trips eliminated is changed from “480” to “469”.

- The percent reduction for the Eastern Area is changed from “36” to “33”.
- The total percent reduction for all areas is changed from “24.71” to “24.39”.

Additionally, each instance of “11/1” in the workbook has been changed to “1/11”.

The previously filed version of USPS-LR-N2012-1/11 should be replaced in its entirety by the version filed today.
