ACCEPTANCE OF LIBRARY REFERENCES APWU-LR-N2012-1/NP1-NP7

In accordance with Rule 21 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the American Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO (APWU) hereby moves for late acceptance of seven Library References: APWU-LR-N2012-1/NP1-NP7. These library references are Category 2 foundation materials relied upon in the rebuttal testimony of APWU witness Mr. Pierre Kacha (APWU-RT-3). Accordingly, these Library References were to have been provided to the Commission yesterday.
