MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF DEADLINE FOR RESPONSE
TO CHAIRMAN'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 2
(April 30, 2012)

On April 13, 2012, the Postal Regulatory Commission issued Chairman's Information Request No. 2, which directed the Postal Service to update the Commission as to the progress of the Postal Service's scoping study relating to a new city carrier street cost study. The Commission requested that the Postal Service respond by May 11, 2012.

Key members of the Postal Service's carrier cost study team are heavily involved in Docket No. N2012-1 and will need to prepare for and attend hearings relating to that docket at the Commission on May 9th and 10th. The Postal Service therefore requests that the Commission extend the deadline for responding to Chairman's Information Request No. 2 by two weeks, to May 25, 2012.
