**NOTICE OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE RESPONSE  
TO ORDER NO. 630 CONCERNING  
GLOBAL EXPEDITED PACKAGE SERVICES -- NON-PUBLISHED RATES 2  
CUSTOMER CONTRACTS WITH SERIAL NUMBERS ENDING:  
0001, 0003-0004, AND 0006-0007  
(May 1, 2012)**

On December 30, 2010, the Postal Regulatory Commission (Commission) issued Order No. 630, adding Global Expedited Package Services Non-Published Rates 2 (GEPS NPR 2) (MC2010-29 and CP2011-45) to the competitive product list.<sup>1</sup> In Order No. 630, the Commission requested that the Postal Service provide cost, volume and revenue data associated with each GEPS NPR 2 agreement that is the subject of this docket.<sup>2</sup> In response to Order No. 630, the Postal Service hereby provides cost, volume and revenue data associated with the GEPS NPR 2 contracts with the following serial numbers:

that recently expired. The unredacted versions of the reports are being filed separately under seal with the Commission.<sup>3</sup> The redacted versions of the reports would appear very similar to the redacted report for the NPR2-FY11-NOV10-N-T2-0002 report that was included in the Postal Service's February 8, 2012 filing in this docket.<sup>4</sup> Therefore, the Postal Service requests that the Commission consider the redacted report for the NPR2-FY11-NOV10-N-T2-0002 agreement as representative of the reports that the Postal Service is filing today under seal with the Commission. The Postal Service incorporates by reference the application for non-public treatment that was filed in conjunction with the Postal Service's December 15, 2010, notice in this docket.<sup>5</sup>
