**NOTICE OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OF
CLASSIFICATION CHANGES**
(May 7, 2012)

Pursuant to 39 C.F.R. §§ 3020.90 and 3020.91, the United States Postal Service (Postal Service) hereby gives notice of a minor change in classification governing the Country Price Lists for International Mail. The change creates a separate country listing for the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste to reflect its independence from Indonesia. The mailing services and price groupings are as follows: Global Express Guaranteed service (6); Single-Piece First-Class Mail International service (6); Priority Mail International service (6); International Priority Airmail service (14); and International Surface Air Lift service (14). Changes to the International Mail Manual to give effect to adding the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste as a separate country are scheduled to be published in the *Postal Bulletin* on May 17, 2012, and will become effective on June 24, 2012.

The Postal Service hereby submits to the Commission the attached conforming changes in the MCS. The Postal Service believes that the changes are consistent with 39 U.S.C. § 3642 and should be incorporated by the Commission into the MCS.
