I've operated my center in Escanaba, Michigan for over 16 years and during those years as a CMRA, I have never been able to offer my customers the ability to have their mail forwarded by the U.S. Postal Service. The same holds true for the center I've owned and operated for 6 years in Marquette, Michigan.

I feel the USPS should not have the ability to restrict a service to CMRAs for so many years and then just be able to offer it as an unfair selling point to potential customers. I feel that the CMRAs have suffered a loss of profit for many years due to that restriction from the USPS. I don't know how that could be made up at this point and it would certainly further harm our profitability if the USPS can offer this service and continue to restrict it for CMRAs.
