OF FILING LIBRARY REFERENCES**
(July 19, 2012)

In accordance with Rule 31(b)(2), the United States Postal Service hereby provides notice today that it is filing the following public library reference in Docket No. N2012-2:

USPS-LR-N2012-2/11	Summary Spreadsheet - Updated
USPS-LR-N2012-2/12	Costing Estimates - Updated
USPS-LR-N2012-2/13	Material Supporting Responses of Postal Service to Questions Posed During Oral Cross-Examination of Witness Day (Draft POSTPlan Customer Survey)

USPS-LR-N2012-2/11 is an updated version of USPS-LR-N2012-1 as requested by the Commission. It also includes data identifying current suspension status, the APO for each RMPO, and the driving distance from each RMPO to its APO. USPS-LR-N2012-2/12 is an updated version of USPS-LR-N2012-2/6 providing estimated labor savings based on the classification of POSTPlan Offices in USPS-LR-N2012-2/11. The preface page included with the library reference describes the contents in more detail.

In USPS-LR-N2012-2/11, the Postal Service changed the status of several Post Offices from RMPOs to PTPOs or EAS Level 18 offices based on the Postal Service's

validation process. The Postal Service also identified 16 offices incorrectly designated as PTPOs in the original Library Reference, which are now classified as RMPOs. Those offices are classified as Level 6 RMPOs regardless of earned workload to accommodate staffing issues. Furthermore, 18 Post Offices that were suspended and not included in USPS-LR-N2012-2/1 have subsequently reopened. These offices are now included in POSStPlan, however, complete data on these offices are not yet in CSDC, and therefore, these 18 offices are not included in USPS-LR-N2012-2/11. A supplemental library reference with these offices will be filed when the data are available.

It should be further noted that the Postal Service is currently conducting a review of all Post Offices to confirm suspension status. The data presented in USPS-LR-N2012-2/11 are correct based on current available information; however, the Postal Service will file an updated USPS-LR-N2012-2/11, if necessary, upon completion of the suspension status validation process.
