We provide call in service, mail forwarding, street addresses and accept packages from all shipping companies for our customers.

As a small business owner, I have to make a profit to stay in business. Obviously, the Post Office does not have to do this and will probably be bailed out from their years of deficits by the Federal Government by giving them stimulus money. I can't even get a loan to expand my business and the Federal Government isn't giving me any stimulus money to help me with the losses I have suffered with the downturn of the economy.
