

Comments from USA Shipping Center, Tyler, TX concerning Docket No MC2012-26-

As a small business owner and a CMRA, I'm concerned about an large entity such as the Post Office trying to put me and others like me out of business by competing on an unlevel playing field.

The new policies of street addresses and accepting packages from non USPS carriers is a change that covers up the fact that mail is being delivered to PO boxes which is deceiving senders as to the true identity of the address. And also affects the signing for items on such things as certified or insured mail.

Adding email notification and storing of the extra packages from non USPS carriers would also create more labor and other cost making these additional or premium services, creating more costs for the box holders.

Mail forwarding is not allowed out of a CMRA but would be from the PO Box with a street address. Allowing the USPS to provide services that we cannot while working in the same arena.
