**NOTICE OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE RESPONSE  
TO ORDER NO. 1161 CONCERNING  
GLOBAL EXPEDITED PACKAGE SERVICES -- NON-PUBLISHED RATES 3  
CUSTOMER CONTRACT WITH SERIAL NUMBER ENDING: 0032  
(September 21, 2012)**

On January 20, 2012, the Postal Regulatory Commission (Commission) issued Order No. 1161, adding Global Expedited Package Services Non-Published Rates 3 (GEPS NPR 3) (MC2012-4 and CP2012-8) to the competitive product list.<sup>1</sup> In Order No. 1161, the Commission requested that the Postal Service provide cost, volume and revenue data associated with each GEPS NPR 3 agreement that is the subject of this docket.<sup>2</sup> In response to Order No. 1161, the Postal Service hereby provides cost, volume and revenue data associated with the GEPS NPR 3 contract with the following serial number: NPR3-FY12-FEB12-MN-T7-0032. This instrument was terminated by a modification.<sup>3</sup>
