The Attachment to Governors' Decision No. 12-2 draft section 2635.2 proposes to add a new range (\$0.00 to \$25.00) of "Shipping Fees" for Shipping and Mailing Supplies. Please identify any fees currently charged for shipping Mailing and Shipping Supplies, and all Postal Service offerings that could be subject to these Shipping Fees.

**RESPONSE:**

At present, there are no shipping fees currently charged that would fall under this category. On January 27, 2013, the only fee that would be added to this category is the expedited shipping fee for packaging, as described in the instant docket. There are no plans to add any other shipping fees to this category at this time. The Postal Service will notify the Commission prior to introducing any other fees under this category.
