**AMENDMENT OF
SHIPPING SERVICES CONTRACT
BETWEEN
THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE

REGARDING PRIORITY MAIL SERVICE AND EXPRESS MAIL SERVICE**

WHEREAS, the United States Postal Service (“the Postal Service”) and [REDACTED] (“Customer”) entered into a shipping services contract regarding Priority Mail service and Express Mail service on January 17, 2013.

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to correct the Regulatory Review and Effective Date paragraph of this contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree that the contract is hereby amended as detailed below. The existing contract remains unchanged in all other respects. This amendment shall become effective one business day after the Commission issues all necessary regulatory approval.

Paragraph III is amended to state the following:

III. Regulatory Review and Effective Date

This contract is subject to approval by Postal Service senior management and/or the Governors of the Postal Service, as well as by the Postal Regulatory Commission (“the Commission”). In accordance with Title 39 and the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, and upon approval of the Postal Service Governors, the Postal Service will make required filings with the Commission. The effective date of this contract shall be one business day following the day on which the Commission issues all necessary regulatory approval.
