ORDER EXTENDING DEADLINE FOR COMMENTS

(Issued May 16, 2013)

On May 14, 2013, several interested persons filed a Joint Motion for Extension of Time requesting an extension of the deadline for filing comments until May 24, 2013.<sup>1</sup> They assert the extra time is warranted in order to consider new information about the Technology Credit Promotion presented by the Postal Service during a May 14, 2013 webinar. They also indicate that other postal-related activities are occurring this week that hinder the filing of comments by the previous deadline.

The Postal Service filed a response indicating that it does not oppose the Motion.<sup>2</sup> If granting the extension might cause a delay with the Commission issuing a

final order, the Postal Service asks the Commission to indicate when it anticipates the final order will be issued to allow for an adjustment to the Postal Service's implementation plans.<sup>3</sup>

The deadline to file comments is extended to May 24, 2013. Commenters are reminded that information presented in the webinar may not reflect the record in this docket.<sup>4</sup> Barring other intervening events in this docket, the Commission anticipates issuing the final order no later than June 7, 2013.
