ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

(Issued May 31, 2013)

On March 20, 2013, Carolina Jalufka (Petitioner) filed a petition for review of the final determination to close the Francitas, Texas post office.<sup>1</sup> On March 28, 2013, the Postal Service notified the Commission that it had “determined to withdraw its Final Determination concerning the Francitas Post Office.”<sup>2</sup> It requests that the proceeding be dismissed. *Id.*

In response to a letter filed by Petitioner, the Postal Service clarified the status of the Francitas post office, stating that it “has not permanently closed the Francitas Post Office. Instead, it has suspended operations.”<sup>3</sup>

On May 29, 2013, Petitioner filed notice withdrawing her appeal based on the understanding that the Francitas post office will reopen on June 17, 2013.<sup>4</sup>

Based on the parties’ filings, the petition for review is dismissed without prejudice.

The Petition for Review, filed March 20, 2013, is dismissed without prejudice.
