ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RELIEF

(Issued June 18, 2013)

The negotiated service agreement approved in this proceeding (Existing Agreement) is set to expire June 30, 2013.<sup>1</sup> The Postal Service requests that the Commission grant an extension until July 7, 2013 to allow the Existing Agreement to remain in effect while the Commission completes its review of a successor agreement filed in Docket No. CP2013-68.<sup>2</sup> The successor agreement has an effective date of July 8, 2013. *Id.* at 3.

The Postal Service represents that the parties were unable to execute the successor agreement until June 13, 2013. Motion at 1. The Postal Service requests that the terms and conditions of the Existing Agreement be extended to ensure that continuity of pricing and other terms and conditions of the Existing Agreement are maintained while the Commission conducts its review. *Id.* at 2.

The Motion is granted. The Existing Agreement is authorized to continue until July 7, 2013. Allowing the Existing Agreement to remain in effect temporarily is in the public interest and will not prejudice any person.

*It is ordered:*

1. The Motion of the United States Postal Service for Temporary Relief, filed June 17, 2013, is granted.
2. The Existing Agreement is authorized to continue through July 7, 2013.
