**NOTICE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OF FILING MODIFICATION  
TO GLOBAL EXPEDITED PACKAGE SERVICES – NON-PUBLISHED RATES 4  
CUSTOMER CONTRACT SERIAL NUMBER ENDING: 0065**

On July 2, 2013, the United States Postal Service (Postal Service) gave notice of filing, in the above-referenced docket, Global Expedited Package Services – Non-Published Rates 4 (GEPS NPR 4) customer agreements with serial numbers ending in 0059, 0061-0062 and 0065-0067.<sup>1</sup> This notice concerns the customer agreement with the serial number NPR4-FY13-APR13-N-T1-0065, an unredacted version of which was filed with the Commission under seal, as part of the Postal Service's July 2, 2013 notice of filing six contracts in this docket.

A modification of the customer agreement with the serial number NPR4-FY13-APR13-N-T1-0065 was recently signed. The modification revises Article 31 to change the name of the Mailer's contact.

A redacted version of the modification is filed publicly as Attachment 1. With respect to the non-public version of the modification that is filed under seal, the Postal

**MODIFICATION ONE TO THE  
GLOBAL CUSTOMIZED MAIL AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE AND**

This Modification amends the Global Customized Mail Agreement ("Agreement") between [REDACTED] ("Mailer") with offices at [REDACTED] and the United States Postal Service ("USPS"), an independent establishment of the Executive Branch of the United States Government, with offices at 475 L'Enfant Plaza SW, Washington, DC 20260-9998, signed by the Mailer on June 6, 2013, and signed by the USPS on June 13, 2013. The Mailer and the USPS may be referred to individually as a "Party" and together as the "Parties."

The purpose of this Modification is to change the name of the Mailer's contact in Article 31. Notices.

Article 31. Notices is changed to read as follows:

All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in force.


The Mailer acknowledges that the Modification and supporting documentation will be filed with the Postal Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in a docketed proceeding (CP2013-35 Serial Number NPR4-FY13-APR13-N-T1-0065). The Mailer authorizes the USPS to determine the scope of information that must be made publicly available in any Commission docketed proceeding in which information related to this Modification must be filed. The Mailer further understands that any unredacted portion of the Modification

or supporting information will be available on the Commission's public website, <http://www.prc.gov>. In addition, the USPS may be required to file information in connection with this instrument (including revenue, cost, or volume data) in other Commission dockets, including Commission docket numbers ACR2013 and ACR2014. The Mailer has the right, in accordance with the Commission's rules, to address its confidentiality concerns directly with the Commission. The procedure for making an application to the Postal Regulatory Commission for non-public treatment of materials believed to be protected from disclosure is found at Title 39, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 3007.22 found on the Commission's website, <http://www.prc.gov/Docs/63/63467/Order225.pdf>.


