**MOTION FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF NON-PUBLIC FILING OF AGREEMENT
AND FINANCIAL WORKPAPERS**
(November 18, 2013)

This notice concerns the inbound portion of a bilateral agreement with Canada Post Corporation (“Canada Post” or “CPC”), which is replacing the agreement reviewed by the Commission in PRC Docket No. R2012-5. The Postal Service filed its Notice of Type 2 Rate Adjustment and Notice of Filing Functionally Equivalent Agreement on Friday, November 15, 2013. The Postal Service, however, was unable to provide the Commission with the non-public version of the relevant portions of the bilateral agreement and financial workpapers in accordance with the Commission’s rules on that same date, despite great effort. This was due to the protracted nature of the negotiation of terms not affecting inbound market dominant rates or service, but nonetheless a part of the main bilateral agreement. The Postal Service asks that the Commission accept the non-public filing of these documents on the next business day. The Postal Service does not believe that any party will be prejudiced by the Commission’s acceptance of its notice and filing of these documents.
