**NOTICE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
OF FILING ERRATA**
(December 6, 2013)

The United States Postal Service hereby gives notice of filing under seal in this docket corrected versions of the following two Excel spreadsheets, which were in the non-public annex included in the Postal Service's November 13, 2013 filing:

- International CS Summary 2014 AR Jan NonPublic.xls
- International CS Summary 2014 AR Oct NonPublic.xls.

The Postal Service discovered a few minor errors in the two Excel spreadsheets that needed to be corrected. The changes to the two Excel spreadsheets include the following:

- The 2014 preliminary terminal dues rates from the Universal Postal Union (UPU) are now available and were installed. These changes affect letterpost settlement costs.
- A change was made to adjust the growth rate for the volume effect for Account 53298 "INTERNATIONAL-FOREIGN POST EXPENSE (OTHER)" to include ISAL volumes which are reflected in the account, but which had been left out of the growth rate calculation.

- 2014 inflation rates had been inadvertently left off and have been updated. These affect the amounts "rolled forward" for the settlement and international air transportation categories of cost segment 14.

In addition, in accordance with 39 C.F.R. § 3015.3, the Postal Service is also filing a certified statement required by 39 C.F.R. § 3015.3(c)(2) concerning the change in rates of general applicability for IPA and ISAL. The statement was not included in the Postal Service's initial notice filed in this proceeding, and is attached to this notice in conjunction with the other corrections made to the materials filed in this docket.

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
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**Certification of Prices for
International Priority Airmail (IPA) and International Surface Air Lift (ISAL)**

I, Stephen J. Nickerson, Manager of Finance (Headquarters), United States Postal Service, am familiar with the change in prices of general applicability for IPA and ISAL established by the Decision of the Governors of the United States Postal Service on Changes in Rates and Classes of General Applicability for Competitive Products, issued October 22, 2013 (Governors' Decision No. 13-02).

I hereby certify that the numerical cost values underlying the prices of general applicability for IPA and ISAL are the appropriate costs to use and represent the best available information. The prices of general applicability for IPA and ISAL should cover their attributable costs and preclude the subsidization of competitive products by market dominant products. International competitive mail accounts for a relatively small percentage of the total contribution by all competitive products. Contribution from IPA and ISAL should be even smaller. The new prices of general applicability for IPA and ISAL should not impair the ability of competitive products on the whole to cover an appropriate share of institutional costs.
