ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RELIEF

(Issued January 14, 2014)

The negotiated service agreement approved in this proceeding (Existing Agreement) is set to expire January 25, 2014.<sup>1</sup> The Postal Service filed a motion requesting that the Commission extend the expiration date of the Existing Agreement.<sup>2</sup>

The Postal Service represents that it intends to initiate a new docket, in which it will file a successor agreement to the Existing Agreement. *Id.* at 1. However, in the interest of maintaining continuity of pricing and other terms and conditions, the Postal Service requests that the Existing Agreement be extended until February 28, 2014. *Id.*

at 1-2. It also states that it has sent a proposed written modification to the Existing Agreement to the customer altering the expiration date to February 28, 2014. *Id.* at 1.

The Motion is granted. The Existing Agreement is authorized to continue through February 28, 2014. Allowing the Existing Agreement to remain in effect temporarily is in the public interest and will not prejudice any person.

Any fully executed modification to the Existing Agreement between the Postal Service and the customer should be filed with the Commission.

*It is ordered:*

1. The United States Postal Service Motion for Temporary Relief, filed January 9, 2014, is granted.
2. The Existing Agreement is authorized to continue through February 28, 2014.
3. If a written modification to the Existing Agreement is fully executed, the Postal Service shall file such modification with the Commission.
