ORDER GRANTING REQUESTS FOR ACCESS

(Issued March 27, 2014)

On March 24, 2014, GameFly, Inc. (GameFly) filed a motion pursuant to 39 C.F.R. § 3007.40 for access to the non-public portion of comments filed by the Postal Service on March 21, 2014.¹ Signed copies of Appendix A of 39 C.F.R. part 3007 are included with the GameFly Motion. Netflix, Inc. (Netflix) also filed a motion pursuant to 39 C.F.R. § 3007.40 on March 24, 2014, for access to non-public portion of

the Postal Service's comments.² The Netflix Motion is accompanied by signed copies of Appendix A of 39 C.F.R. part 3007.

Both GameFly and Netflix acknowledge willingness to comply with protective conditions and identify the individuals to be granted access. *Id.* at 2; GameFly Motion at 2. GameFly and Netflix state that the individuals they identify have previously been granted access to non-public material in the above-captioned dockets. GameFly Motion at 1-2; Netflix Motion at 1-2. Both GameFly and Netflix require access to the non-public portions of the Postal Service's comments in order to determine whether further responses are necessary in reply comments due April 4, 2014.

GameFly states that both the Postal Service and Netflix consent to its Motion. GameFly Motion at 1. Netflix states that both GameFly and the Postal Service consent to its Motion. Netflix Motion at 2.

Accordingly, GameFly and Netflix are granted access to the non-public portions of the Postal Service comments filed March 21, 2014, effective upon the issuance of this Order.

It is ordered:

1. GameFly and Netflix are granted access to the non-public portions of the United States Postal Service Comments Addressing Responses to Chairman's Information Request Nos. 1, 2, and 3, March 21, 2014.
