ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR ADJUSTMENT TO PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

(Issued April 2, 2014)

On March 28, 2014, the Commission issued a Notice and Order which, among other things, set forth the procedural schedule in this docket.¹ Order No. 2035 established April 11, 2014 as the deadline for initial comments and April 18, 2014 as the deadline for reply comments. Order No. 2035 at 3.

On April 1, 2014, the Public Representative filed a motion petitioning the Commission to adjust the procedural schedule established in Order No. 2035.² She requests that the Commission extend the initial and reply comment deadlines to 30 days and 45 days after the issuance of Order No. 2035, respectively. She asserts this adjustment would further the public interest by allowing parties more time to develop a

complete record. She represents that the Postal Service does not object to the adjustment. Motion at 1.

In order to promote thorough development of the record, the Commission grants the Motion. Initial comments are due no later than April 28, 2014. Reply comments are due no later than May 12, 2014.

It is ordered:

1. The Public Representative Unopposed Motion for Adjustment to Procedural Schedule, filed April 1, 2014, is granted.
2. Comments by interested persons are due no later than April 28, 2014.
3. Reply comments are due no later than May 12, 2014.
