WHEREAS, the United States Postal Service (“the Postal Service”) and [REDACTED] (“Customer”) entered into a shipping services contract regarding Priority Mail service on December 4th, 2013.

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the terms in Section I. B. and I.C for Customer.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree that the contract is hereby amended as detailed below. The existing contract remains unchanged in all other respects. This amendment shall become effective one business day following the day on which the Commission issues all necessary regulatory approval.


**I. Terms**

B. This contract applies to Customer’s Priority Mail [REDACTED] (“Contract Packages”).

C. Customer will utilize eVS and PC Postage payment methods for shipments and returns of such packages. Outbound Contract Packages must originate from the following Customer locations:

Upon 15 days’ notice by Customer of any additional Customer location utilizing eVS or PC Postage, such location shall automatically be included as a location from which outbound Contract Packages may originate, provided the package level detail for such location is not materially different from any of the previously included locations.
