NOTICE OF INTERVENTION

The Parcel Shippers Association (PSA) hereby files notice of its intervention in the above-captioned proceeding.

1. Intervenor is an association consisting of approximately 200 members, primarily small businesses, from every section of the nation. Its members make use of parcel post service which is a part of Standard (B) class of mail. Additionally, the membership of the association makes use of First Class Mail; Standard (A) mail, and parcel return service.

2. It is the position of PSA that the current charge for parcel return service may be based on incorrect cost estimates and therefore may have cost coverage that is excessive under applicable criteria in the Postal Reorganization Act.




