**MOTION FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE'S  
REVENUE COLLECTION REPORT FOR QUARTER 4 OF FISCAL YEAR 2014**

The Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of its report on the amount of exigent surcharge revenue collected during the quarter ending September 30, 2014, two days out of time.<sup>1</sup> Extra time beyond the deadline of November 14, 2014 was needed due to the press of business and delays in the finalization of supporting workpapers. Given the minimal delay in filing the required information, the Postal Service does not believe that any party will be prejudiced by the Commission's acceptance of this report.
