RESPONSE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
TO CHAIRMAN'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 9

1. On February 5, 2015, in response to Chairman's Information Request No. 6, question 17, the Postal Service provided Excel file "CAPCALC-PER-R2015-4-ChIR6Q17.xls." Excel file "CAPCALC-PER-R2015-4-ChIR6Q17.xls," tab "Outside County," cell H201 contains a \$0.001 discount for FS IM incentive. This incentive for Outside County Periodicals is not referenced in the Postal Service's proposed revised Mail Classification Schedule (MCS).¹
 - a. Please confirm that a \$0.001 FS IM incentive discount will apply on a piece basis to Outside County as well as In-County Periodicals.
 - b. If confirmed, please provide the applicable revised pages of the MCS. If not confirmed, please provide revised workpapers.

RESPONSE:

- a. Confirmed.
- b. Attachment A generally shows only sections of the MCS that have changes, with some unchanged sections included for context or editing simplicity. See Attachment A, page 1. As a result, while the In-County Periodicals FS IM incentive is included in Attachment A, the existing language governing the Outside County FS IM incentive is excluded, and replaced with "* * * * *". The existing language for Outside County remains in effect; no changes to the MCS are necessary to retain the existing \$0.001 incentive.
