Dear Secretary Grove:

I write in support of the appeals submitted by my constituents in Idaho to the Postal Regulatory Commission (PRC) regarding the proposed closure of the Careywood Post Office (Docket Number A2015-2).

During a recent town meeting I held in the region, approximately 100 residents affected by the closure of this postal facility attended to share their disappointment with this move by the United States Postal Service (USPS). A post office has been in Careywood for over one hundred years, and the current facility slated for closure has been in operation since 1933. There is a strong need for reliable postal services in this community and significant concerns have been shared with me regarding the impact and expenses that will be levied on residents with the closure of the Careywood facility. To illustrate the strong public support for this post office, I have enclosed a petition containing nearly 500 signatures that has been shared with my office.

In closing, I strongly encourage the PRC to fully consider the appeal submitted by my constituents affected by the closure of this post office.
