**SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION TO THE NOTICE OF UNITED STATES  
POSTAL SERVICE OF RATES NOT OF GENERAL APPLICABILITY**  
(April 1, 2015)


The United States Postal Service (Postal Service) hereby provides further supplemental information concerning the notice of rates for Inbound EMS 2, consistent with the Postal Service's initial filing of supplemental information filed on October 1, 2014 in this docket.<sup>1</sup> In the October 1, 2014 filing, the Postal Service proposed to identify to the Commission, in its Quarter 3, FY 2015 quarterly filing, the countries for which the Inbound EMS 2 rates exceeded the maximum rates identified in the Postal Service's July 11, 2014 filing. The table below reflects the countries and rates, to date, for which the Inbound EMS 2 rates exceed the maximum rates previously filed. These changes only resulted in the Postal Service increasing the rates charged to foreign EMS operators, so there is no negative impact on the Commission's previous determination that inbound EMS 2 covers its attributable costs.

The Postal Service maintains, for the reasons set forth in its Application for Non-Public Treatment filed in this docket on July 11, 2014, that the rate information provided below should remain confidential.
