**UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE MOTION FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE  
OF THE FILING OF RESPONSES TO QUESTIONS 1 THROUGH 4  
OF CHAIRMAN'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 3**  
(May 14, 2105)

The United States Postal Service moves for late acceptance of the filing of its responses to Questions 1 through 4 of Chairman's Information Request No. 3. The responses were due to have been filed by May 8, 2015 -- four business days and six calendar days ago. Preparation of the responses to these questions required consultations among personnel who are primarily responsible for development and implementation of the proposed service measurement system, and who have been heavily engaged in the internal consultations that are serving as the basis for the Postal Service's reply comments that will be filed on May 18, 2015. As a result, they were unable to complete responses to Questions 1-4 until today. The Postal Service regrets any inconvenience to those who were relying on the responses being filed on time. However, the Postal Service does not consider that any party has been prejudiced by the delay in filing until today. Accordingly, the Postal Service respectfully requests that this motion be granted.
