Dear Ms. Grove:

Pursuant to 39 U.S.C. § 407(d)(2), the Postal Service is providing copies of an agreement between the Postal Service and Royal Mail Group Limited ("Royal Mail") regarding the Exprès Services Agreement initially filed in Docket No. R2011-6. The Postal Service has marked the non-public version of the document as "Confidential" and "Non-Public" because the document contains information considered confidential and commercially sensitive by the Postal Service and Royal Mail.

The Postal Service considers certain portions of the documents to be protected by 39 U.S.C. § 410(c)(2) and thereby not subject to mandatory disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). Further, the documents contain the commercial information of Royal Mail, and as such, certain portions of the instruments are subject to protection under Exemption 4 of the FOIA. Consequently, the Postal Service incorporates the Application for Non-Public Treatment filed as Attachment 1 to the Postal Service's Notice in Docket No. R2011-6. In addition, we respectfully request that the Postal Regulatory Commission coordinate with us in the event that any of the documents become subject to a FOIA request, so that we can engage in appropriate consultations with the affected postal operators.

Dear Mr. Simpson:

I am writing to confirm the arrangement reached between the United States Postal Service (USPS) and the Royal Mail Group Limited (Royal Mail) regarding the remuneration for the delivery of certain Exprès items pursuant to the Exprès Services Agreement.

Both the USPS and Royal Mail are parties to the multilateral Exprès Services Agreement. Pursuant to Article 8 of the Exprès Services Agreement, the USPS and Royal Mail hereby agree to deviate from the provisions of the agreement with respect to remuneration and service features applicable between the USPS and Royal Mail for certain Exprès items.

This deviation from the Exprès Services Agreement became effective on June 1, 2014, and will remain in effect until either party provides the other party with a written notice of termination of this deviation. Any notice of termination will be provided at least three months in advance of the termination date. USPS and Royal Mail further agree that [REDACTED]

USPS and Royal Mail agree to settle this payment separately from any other payments made by either post pursuant to the Exprès Services Agreement. All other terms of the Exprès Services Agreement remain in effect and unaltered, including, without limitation, the terms that relate to the timing and process for making payments under the Exprès Services Agreement.

Please note that, consistent with the USPS Deed of Accession (Annex 5 to the Exprès Services Agreement) and paragraph 6(d) of the related Notice Provided to the International Post Corporation and Parties to the Exprès Services Agreement concerning the United States Postal Service's Participation in the Exprès Services Agreement, copies of this instrument will be furnished to the U.S. Department of State and the U.S. Postal Regulatory Commission, and portions of this instrument may become publicly available on the U.S. Postal Regulatory Commission's website.
