NOTICE OF REVISIONS TO PROPOSAL NINE AND REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

(Issued May 20, 2015)

On May 8, 2015, the Postal Service filed a report addressing matters raised at an April 14, 2015, technical conference, along with a notice concerning the filing of two library references and an application for nonpublic treatment of material in one of the library references.¹ The Report and May 8, 2015 Notice address revisions to Proposal Nine and the supporting library references.²
