**NOTICE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OF FILING REVISIONS TO
REVENUE COLLECTION REPORT FOR QUARTER 2 OF FISCAL YEAR 2015**
(May 22, 2015)

In accordance with Order No. 2075, issued on May 2, 2014,¹ the Postal Service filed its report on the amount of exigent surcharge revenue collected for the quarter ending March 31, 2015 (“Revenue Collection Report” or “Report”) on May 15th.² In its filing, the Postal Service noted that certain information requested in Presiding Officer’s Information Request No. 17 (“POIR No. 17”), which was due on May 15, 2015, would be filed with the Commission this week. In particular, the Postal Service explained that it still needed to provide responses to question 37(f-h) and make conforming changes to the supporting workpapers for Quarters 2 thru 4 of FY 2014.³ Since the outstanding information was likely to impact the calculation of the overall surcharge revenue collected to date, the Postal Service pledged to file revisions to the Revenue Collection Report once the outstanding information was submitted.⁴

The outstanding information requested in POIR No. 17 was submitted to the Commission today, May 22, 2015. Accordingly, the Postal Service hereby files revisions to the Revenue Collection Report for Quarter 2 of FY 2015. These revisions

affect only the Excel workbook *ExigSrchgRevCUMLTV(2-4Q15 and 1-2Q15).xlsx*, which was filed on May 15, 2015.⁵ Revisions to this file are highlighted in yellow in the revised file, which is being submitted concurrently with this pleading as *ExigSrchgRevCUMLTV(2Q14-2Q15)Rev522.xlsx*.⁶ The Postal Service can now report that the cumulative exigent surcharge revenue reported on May 15, 2015 has decreased by \$4 million to \$2.511 billion.⁷
