ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTIONS FOR ACCESS

(Issued June 9, 2015)

On June 9, 2015, the Postal Service filed a motion seeking access to materials filed under seal by United Parcel Service (UPS).¹ Amazon Fulfillment Services, Inc. (Amazon) also filed an unopposed motion for access to the same materials.²

The Postal Service Motion indicates that the non-public materials, per the representation of UPS, only contain the Postal Service's non-public material originally filed in the docket as Library Reference USPS-RM2015-7/NP1. Postal Service Motion

at 1. The Postal Service also indicates its support for future access (subject to protective conditions) to any non-public materials based exclusively on the Postal Service's Library References USPS-RM2015-7/NP1 and USPS-RM2015-7/NP2 by those parties that have gained access to these Library References subject to protective conditions. *Id.* at 2.

Amazon seeks access to the same non-public materials and represents that the Postal Service does not oppose the request. Amazon Motion at 1. Amazon identifies the individuals that will have access subject to protective conditions and attaches executed protective conditions. *Id.* at 2, Appendix A.

Both the Postal Service Motion and the Amazon Motion are granted.

It is ordered:

1. The Motion of the United States Postal Service for Access to Materials Filed Under Seal by United Parcel Service, filed June 9, 2015, is granted.
2. The Unopposed Motion of Amazon Fulfillment Services, Inc., for Access to Documents Filed by United Parcel Service, Inc., filed June 9, 2015, is granted.
3. The United States Postal Service and Amazon Fulfillment Services, Inc. shall have immediate access to the non-public materials identified as "UPS-LR-RM2015-7/NP1."
