PUBLIC REPRESENTATIVE MOTION
FOR ISSUANCE OF INFORMATION REQUEST

(August 6, 2015)

Pursuant to Rules 39 C.F.R. §3001.21(a) and 39 C.F.R. §3007.3(c), the Public Representative requests that an Information Request be issued to obtain additional clarifying data and explanation from the Postal Service concerning its proposal to change the methodology used for measuring the national totals of revenue, pieces, and weight (RPW) in the RPW Report for Click-N-Ship (CNS) Priority Mail.¹ Responses to the questions posed below are intended to enhance understanding of Proposal Six so as to allow participants to provide more constructive comments and evaluate whether the proposal meets applicable legal and regulatory requirements. Obtaining this information will also contribute to a better understanding of how the Postal Service has interpreted Commission rules and allow the Commission to make a fully informed, reasoned determination on whether the Proposal Six meets applicable legal and regulatory requirements, including 39 U.S.C. §3622(c)(10) and 39 C.F.R. part 3010.

Proposed Questions

1. Please indicate what library references of the Annual Compliance Report (ACR) will be impacted by the proposed changes. If applicable, please list the names of the impacted library references and the corresponding spreadsheets.

2. With the reference to the Q1 FY 2015 RPW Report, please indicate the impact of the proposed changes on the overall Priority Mail revenue, volume and weight. Please provide all the applicable spreadsheets in support of your calculations.

3. On page 8 of the Proposal Six you refer to the mechanism of the BRAF process and, in particular, to Docket No. RM2015-9, currently pending with the Commission. Please indicate if the methodological changes proposed in Docket No. RM2015-9 would provide any additional impact on the CNS Priority Mail revenue, pieces and weight. Please quantify the amount of such impact, if applicable.
