MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
TO EXTEND FILING DEADLINE
(August 14, 2015)

In Order No. 2075,¹ issued May 2, 2014, the Commission ordered the Postal Service to file quarterly reports on the amount of exigent surcharge revenue collected, 45 days after the close of the quarter. Although the Postal Service intended to meet the August 14, 2015 deadline for filing the FY2015, Quarter 3 exigent surcharge revenue report (“Report”), as stated below, various complications require further preparation. The Postal Service hereby moves to extend the Report deadline to August 19, 2015.²

Additional time beyond the August 14, 2015 deadline is needed because the price change that went into effect on May 31, 2015 added to the complexity of preparing the Report. The timing of the price change in the middle of Quarter 3 necessitated the development of two sets of billing determinant data and the incorporation of structural changes that created new or revised cells in the billing determinants. The Postal Service therefore believes more time is needed to prepare the Report.

Thus, the Postal Service respectfully requests that the Commission grant this motion to extend the deadline for filing the Report to August 19, 2015.
